Edward Streeter, of San Diego, passed away at home in his sleep June 27, 2018 at the age of 88 after a brief battle with cancer. He was born May 25, 1930 in Chicago, IL, the son of Clarence “Doc” Streeter and Ruth TeleeStreeter. Ed graduated with a Bachelor’s degree from the University of Illinois, Class of 1951 where he met and married his wife, Marilyn Kwinn Streeter. Following graduation, he served with the US Air Force as a pilot during the Korean War, worked for 30 years for Hughes Aircraft and had three children. After Marilyn passed away in 1975, Ed was married to Carol Fowler Streeter from 1979-2005.

Ed loved sports of all kinds, but especially youth baseball and basketball. Starting with coaching teams for his two sons, he coached youth baseball and basketball for nearly 50 years, “retiring” in 2010. In more recent years he “adopted” the Torrey Pines High School baseball and boy’s basketball and girl’s volleyball teams, virtually never missing a game as their #1 fan.

Surviving Ed are his son, Ed and his son’s wife Stephanie; his son, Bill;his daughter, Mara; and his five grandchildren: Ben, Sam, Zeke, Connie and Alexandra; his sister, Darlene Wyosnick and her husband, David; his ex-wife Carol; and many nieces and nephews.
