She always mentioned that one should not only open the doors and wait for customers to visit. Direct sales were her strength, and she was known in almost every town and village. Business boomed, and she established a store in Charlestown Nevis.

In came the twenty-first century, the winds and tides began shifting, and the economy's growth slowed. Certainly! This tempo was unbearable for my dear aunt . Therefore, she packed and ventured into new frontiers. She relocated to the United States and settled in Oklahoma for a while and then to San Diego in California. Here she settled and she was employed by the department of health.

My aunt always ensured that the lines of communication stayed connected with the whatsapp calls. Today, with sorrow, I say goodbye to my Master teacher, Aunt Constance. The administrator,
