Gloria Vazquez Randall of Clairemont Mesa in San Diego passed on Wednesday evening February 15, 2023. She was surrounded by her immediate family and friends. Her death was caused by a brain injury. She was 80 years old and lived in San Diego for most of her life.

She was known for her humor, generous spirit, and sharp wit. She made many a meal at home for guests and family when they came by for a visit. She loved to travel and loved the vistas in the Grand Canyon, Sedona, Lake Tahoe and others.

She was preceded by her brother Ramon and her brother Alfonso. She is survived by her brothers David and Ezekiel, her sisters Esther, Celia, and Angelina, her children Danny Platas, Elizabeth Platas, and Rosa Randall. She has many grandchildren, and great

grandchildren. Her grandchildren are Dominic, Elizabeth, Erika, Joseph, Jessica, Tony, and Enrique. Her great grandchildren are Valeria, Jazzlyn, Alayan and Ayla.

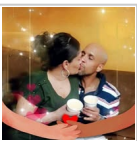
