I remember his birthday parties with a piñata I was always too shy to hit. But grabbing the candy was fun.

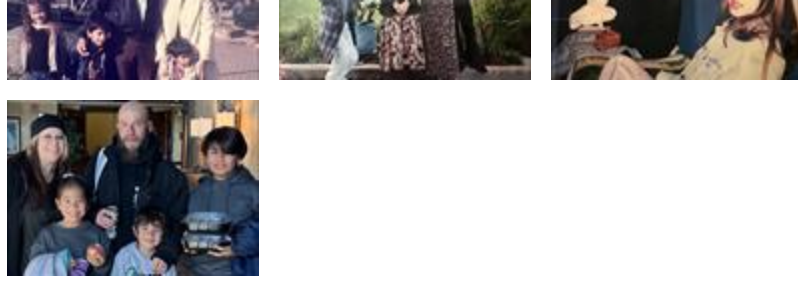
