Maria Luisa Loredo Valdez 76 of Lemon Grove, California, passed away on 25 May 2020. She was born to parents Sidronio Loredo and Atanasia Arvizu, on 10 June 1943 in San Luis Potosi, Mexico, but resided most of her life in Saucillo, Chihuahua, Mexico.

She graduated from Rodolfo Chavez Elementary School, studying Basic Academia in General Primary School Education in 1958, and proudly graduated with a Certificate of Graduation and Completion.
