Marilyn Carol Oblinger passed away on Saturday August 29th at her home in Julian California. She was born at Mercy Hospital July 22nd 1943. She was the Daughter of the late Ernest and Muriel Rubino. Raised in Chula Vista Calif, she graduated from Chula Vista High School in 1961 and worked as a retail clerk for Vons grocery Co. for 37 years. She had many interest such as collecting and displaying Dept 56 villages....She loved going to her local Thai chi group... travelling around the country visiting family ...volunteering in her home town of Julian...Marilyn would always remember everyone's birthday and send them a sweet card to remember them by. Her and her husband Larry would love to go and check out the local estate sales and flea markets to see if they could find something special to add to their collections...

Marilyn went in for a surgery on May 18th to fix a compressed nerve in her throat which had bothered her for years. The surgery did not go well and she suffered complications ie:a brain bleed ;a stroke; and a heart attack She started recovering from that and was doing pretty good then she fell while unattended in a nursing home hit the back of her head and suffered another hematoma and was unresponsive for days Again ...she rallied ...but she was never the same...she spent 14 weeks in hospitals and acute care homes and she wanted to come home desperately. Her Husband Larry, her Daughter Darcie which came out from South Carolina and her Nephew Michael all got together and with the help of Los Robles Hospice made it possible for her to spend her last days on this earth at her home and with people that loved her.

She is survived by her husband Lawrence Mead Oblinger. daughters Darcie Savage of South Carolina and Lacie Hughes of San Diego. brother Richard Racine of San Fransisco. sister Diana Rubino of Chula Vista. Sister in law Margaret Lapham. Nephews Cary, Michael, Nathan, Jonathan and Matthew. niece Christine. grandchildren Wyatt, Winnie, Steel, Colt and Koa .great-grandchildren Waylon & Harlyn .
