It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of our beloved father, brother, and uncle,

Milton Beope. He was born and raised in Calexico, Ca by his parents Pedro Tanco Beope and

Julia Carlon Beope. He graduated from Calexico High School in 1965 and shortly thereafter

joined the US Army. He served for over a year in Bad Kissingen, Germany where he was lucky

enough to find three Calexicans also stationed on the same base. Gus Lopez, Hector Salgado,

and Silver Martinez became his life long friends through their shared military experience.

Upon his return to the States Milton settled in San Diego where he worked for Carnation until it

was sold. He later returned to live in Imperial Valley and worked for Volunteer's of America until

his retirement. He was friends to many, especially those who struggled in their journey to sobriety.

Milton had three sons who he loved deeply and was very proud of their accomplishments. Joe,

who lives in Chicago with his wife Deanna; Nikolai, who is a professor of English at Imperial Valley Community College; and Justin, a businessman in San Diego. He was preceded in death by his father, Pedro and mother, Julia, and his brother, Peter. He leaves behind his three sons, sisters, Gloria Mercado and Frances Beope, sister-in-law Gwenn Beope along with his cherished nieces, nephews, and great nieces/nephews. 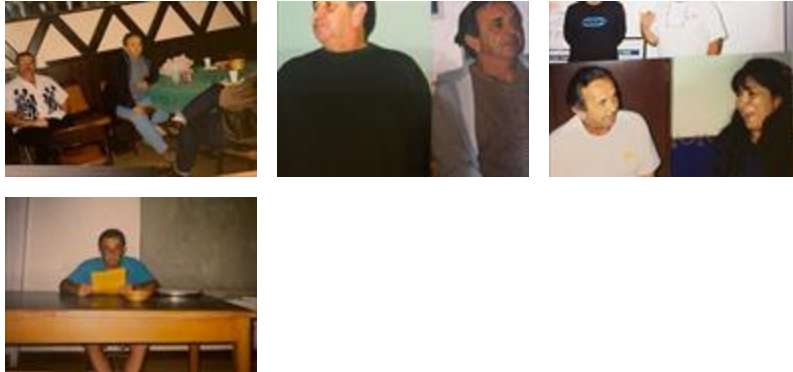
