NANCI LOVEDAY HENEHAN, of San Diego, California, USA passed away at 73 years of age on February 13, 2023 at Alpine View Lodge in Alpine, California due to complications from Alzheimer's Disease.

Nanci was born on May 13, 1949 in Buffalo, New York, USA. Her parents were Paul E. Loveday and June Jamison Loveday. Nanci was the only girl with 3 brothers Larry, Neil and Marc Loveday.

Nanci graduated from school in Kenmore East, New York, attended Alfred State College where she met Kenneth W. Henehan. Eventually, these two married on April 27, 1968.

Nanci lived in Buffalo, Rochester and then Clarkson, New York area before relocating to Coronado, California in 1994 for Ken's job at Kodak. In 2009, they moved to Little Italy in San Diego and began spending part of the year in Keystone, Colorado.

Nanci held various positions over the years including being a stay-at-home Mom for Kellie & Kyle,

babysitter, cashier at RIT & Hamlin's IGA before becoming a special education teacher aide. As the kids grew-up, Nanci moved into accounting roles at Track'n Trail Ski Shop in Brockport, NY, Hotel Del Coronado, and the City of Coronado, California where Nanci worked until she retired after 15 years of service.

Nanci, despite not loving "organized sports", engaged in a variety of hobbies including sailing, downhill & XC skiing, horseback riding and jumping, golfing in the annual family tournament, white water rafting trips, Kids on the Block puppeteer, writers workshops, community theatre, 4-H Mom and was a Special Olympics volunteer. In fact, Nanci would remind us that she was the one who introduced Ken to sailing & skiing.

Nanci's favorite hobby was raising animals and her most favorite were the horses. She had a love for horses from a young age and was fortunate to have her dream of having horses come true! Nanci had 2 horses (Sonny & Julie Jo) at our farm in Clarkson, New York. It was Julie Jo who Nanci bonded with and together they had the opportunity to ride and jump competitively locally and even showing at the New York State Fair!

Nanci enjoyed sailing on her family's 7-11 sailboat at the cottage on Lake Chautauqua in Bemus Point, New York. The Claddagh at Brockport Yacht Club on Lake Ontario and

then in San Diego on
the An Dara Claddagh where we enjoy competitive sailing with family and
friends.

Nanci skied with her family for over 40 years in New York, Vermont, Utah and
most recently at
Keystone, Colorado where she skied with her grandkids. As much as Nanci
