Roger Wade Bolerjack resident of La Mesa California died at the San Diego VA Medical Center on November 10 2014 at 8:22pm due to surgery complications. He was only 52 years old, born December 2 1961 in Tacoma, Washington to Bert (deceased) and Janeth Bolerjack.

He lived in many places throughout his life including Japan, California, England, Hawaii and France. Growing up Roger loved reading and could finish a book filled with hundreds of pages within a day. His life was packed with adventure beyond the bounds of a book.

He was also a huge sports fan. His favorite team was the Dallas Cowboys and always enjoyed watching the Chargers win.

His pride and purpose in life was providing for his family. He gave self-less-ly

every day to the ones he loved. He was happily married to Rachel for 28 years who he said repeatedly was his better half. He is survived by his loving wife Rachel, his children Joseph, David, Matthew, and Crystal (Nevada) and one grandson named Ryder (Nevada), Mother Janeth (Texas), Brother Calvin, and sisters Jeanett and Monica (Texas). Roger was a kind, strong, honest, and loyal man and his spirit will live on through all of us.
